Prerequisites: Must be 18 years of age; Medical approval to dive; current First Aid & CPR training; currently certified NAUI Master Diver & Rescue Diver or equivalent; 60 logged dives minimum; candidates must provide all their own dive equipment in accordance with standards. All candidates must demonstrate water skills required for all NAUI leadership ratings. Contact the Course Director for a complete description of required skills.

Required Material: All candidates must possess the NAUI S&P and Risk Management Handbook, NAUI Leadership Textbook and NAUI Leadership Workbook. These materials are included in the course tuition. Tuition rates will be adjusted for candidates who already own all or portions of the required material. Check with the Course Director for details. Candidates are encouraged to request their materials prior to the start of the ITC.

Course Format: The NAUI Divemaster Course requires minimally 20 hours of academic class time plus pool and open water time. Pool and open water dives will be scheduled in addition to the classroom schedule. Class time is scheduled as follows:

Friday 6:30 PM to 9:30 PM	Course Orientation & Divemaster Duties
Saturday 9:00 AM to 6:00 PM	AM – Lecture: NAUI Orientation & Legal Responsibilities PM – Pool: Water skills; Lecture: Shore Diving , Boat Diving & Emergency Procedures
Sunday 9:00 AM to 6:00 PM	AM - Lecture: Night Diving, Rescue & Deep Diving PM - Lecture: Environments & Equipment; Written Examination

Tuition: \$625.00 includes required NAUI materials listed above, all pool and boat charter fees, air or nitrox fills as required, support materials provided by the course staff, all instruction and graduation banquet for the candidate and his or her guest. Payment of tuition does not guarantee certification. Tuition does NOT include meals, travel, lodging or any other expenses except those specifically listed above.
