First Aid / CPR

Oxygen Administration

Will you be ready if the need arises? Divers often travel where a longer response time from EMS is likely. Therefore, being trained to respond in the unlikely event of a diving emergency can save time and possibly a life. The NAUI First Aid, CPR and O2 Administration courses will prepare you to respond on and off the water!

Prerequisites: No diving experience or certification is required. These programs also fulfill the prerequisite requirements for all NAUI Rescue and Leadership programs including Asst. Instructor, Dive-master and Instructor.

Course Structure: This program is divided into the three component parts. Sessions will include classroom review of emergency response topics and skill practice sessions. Comfortable clothing is recommended. Specific dates will be scheduled and posted at the shop.

- Session 1 - First Aid
- Session 2 - First Aid
- Session 3 - CPR
- Session 4 - O2 Administration

The written exam will be completed during the final classroom session and after the candidate has successfully completed all practical skills station.

- NAUI C-Card for First Aid/CPR and O2 Administration for the Professional Rescuer (Card awarded upon completion of all program requirement.) Certification is valid for two years.

Equipment: No special equipment is needed. All first aid training materials are provided by the course instructor. Students should wear comfortable clothing and come prepared to participate in practical skill development sessions during each class session.

Course Tuition: Training may be completed as a combined program or separately for First Aid, - CPR and Oxygen Administration. Tuition includes classroom instruction, all student materials and certification fees.

First Aid/CPR - Three sessions, tuition \$100.00

O2 Administration - One session, tuition \$50.00

Combined Program Four sessions, tuition \$125.00

Refresher/Challenge - If previously certified. One session, Tuition \$65.00

Additional Requirements: None. These safety programs are open to the general public. Diving experience is not required.
